Important Information Regarding Your UI Tax Forms

Unemployment Insurance payments are taxable. If you were paid unemployment insurance benefits in 2018, you will receive a 1099G form for your tax filing. The Department will mail your 1099G no later than January 31, 2019 as required by law.

Once the 1099G has been issued and mailed, you will see this information in Claimant Portal on your Welcome screen. This information is also available by calling 800-983-2300 and selecting option 5.

If you changed your mailing address after you were paid your last unemployment insurance payment, you must submit a written address change request to the Claims Center in order to have your 1099G mailed to your correct address. These documents are not forwarded by the Post Office.
