MEALS and LODGING ALLOWANCE — INCREASE —

Indicated below is Vermont's Meals and Lodging Allowance.

Effective **January 1, 2009**, and on each **January 1 thereafter**, the meals and lodging rates shall increase by five percent or the percentage increase of the Consumer Price Index, CPI-U, U.S. city average, not seasonally adjusted, or successor index, as calculated by the U.S. Department of Labor or successor agency for the 12 months preceding the previous **September 1**, whichever is smaller.

Effective January 1, 2018

An employer shall be entitled to deduct from the wages earned an allowance for meals and lodging actually furnished and accepted as follows:

Breakfast	\$3.09 daily
Lunch	\$3.47 daily
Dinner	\$3.85 daily
Full Board	\$10.41 daily or \$72.87 per week
Nightly Lodging	\$4.25 daily
Full Room	\$25.51 weekly
Full room and Board	\$88.11 per week
