## Workers' Compensation Assessment Fund

What is the Workers' Compensation Assessment Fund?

The workers' compensation administration fund was created to provide the funds necessary to administer Vermont's Workers' Compensation Program.

The fund consists of contributions from employers, based on the Workers' Compensation Assessment Rate.

Current Workers' Compensation Assessment Rates:

Insurance Companies:

- Effective June 8, 2017 the assessment rate will be **1.4%**.

Self-Insured:

- **1%** of workers' compensation losses during the preceding calendar year.
