Responds to incidents of fire, medical emergency, bomb threat, flooding, water discharge, elevator emergency, hazardous materials, inclement weather, and other incidents. Prepares logs and reports as required. Responsibilities may include any and all protection and security services as required by the client and directed by GMCS.

Requirements: Must be able to meet and continue to meet any applicable state, county, and municipal licensing requirements for Security Officers. 18 years or older. High level of confidentiality and ability to handle sensitive situations. Excellent communication skills. Guest service oriented. Work locations vary. Travel required.
