Am I Eligible for The Hilton Honors Military Program?



To be eligible for The Hilton Honors Military Program, a person must:

- Have served in the U.S Armed Forces for at least 180 days and have been discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable (*Active service includes full-time duty in the National Guard or a Reserve component*)
- Be a resident of or reside in Vermont or moving to Vermont from a state that does not offer the Hilton Honors program
- Provide a copy of a valid DD214 or if on active duty a copy of active military ID card
- Create a jobseeker account at VermontJobLink.com
- Have active job search activity and is "work ready"
- Be required to travel over 50 miles from his or her current residence to participate in an employment activity
- Create a Hilton Honors account at JoinHonors.com
- Have a valid e-mail address

What is a Job Search Activity?

- Scheduled Job Interview
- Job Training/Skills Upgrade Workshop or Class
- Housing Search upon an accepted job offer
