How do I get licensed to adjust workers' compensation claims in Vermont?

The Department of Financial Regulation (DFR) licenses all insurance adjusters doing business in Vermont, including those who adjust workers' compensation claims for out-of-state carriers. To find out about licensing requirements, examinations, and relicensing information, contact DFR with the link below.

What continuing education is offered in Vermont?

In order to be re-licensed to adjust Vermont workers' compensation claims, adjusters must receive continuing education credit by attending Vermont Department of Labor sponsored trainings.
