

Disaster Unemployment Assistance (DUA) Application Process:



YOU ARE LAID OFF OR UNABLE TO WORK DUE TO THE FLOOD

If you are unable to access work or your employer has laid you off, you can apply for unemployment insurance.

APPLY FOR REGUALR UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (UI)

Apply for regular UI to determine eligibility first. Call the initial application phone line at 1-877-214-3330 or visit the online application portal at labor.vermont.gov.

COMPLETE THE INITIAL DUA APPLICATION

If you are not eligible for regular UI, you will be prompted to complete an application for DUA over the phone. Starting Wednesday, July 19, you can also apply for DUA online.

LOG IN EVERY WEEK YOU ARE UNEMPLOYED AND FILE YOUR WEEKLY CLAIM

You must apply for weekly DUA benefits to continue receiving payment, just like regular UI.
