

Vermont Afterschool



ABOUT

Vermont Afterschool, along with key partners at the [Vermont Department for Children and Families](#) and [Let's Grow Kids](#), will coordinate Governor Phil Scott's recent [directive](#) to increase school-age child care this fall.

The state will direct \$12 million in federal coronavirus relief funding to increase the capacity of the school-age child care system in Vermont (which includes afterschool and out-of-school time programs). This expansion will support thousands of children and youth in grades K-6 who need a safe place to be during remote school learning days, not to mention peace of mind for working families who need the care.

Approximately \$6.9 million of the funding will be used to create regional childcare hubs for remote learning days and almost \$5 million is for expanding the Child Care Financial Assistance Program (CCFAP). The money set aside for the school-age programs would cover start-up and expansion costs but not tuition for children. All programs must adhere to [COVID health and safety guidance](#) issued by the Vermont Department of Health.

In addition to identifying regional "hubs" of out-of-school time programs, Vermont Afterschool and Let's Grow Kids will also be identifying new locations to accommodate increased need for school-age care. The governor's order also lifts restrictions on home-based care providers, allowing them to be reimbursed for more than four hours of child-care. Afterschool, out-of-school time, and school-age hubs are hiring! Make a positive difference in kids' lives.
